Program Description

The 9th Annual TBI Summer Institute is designed for education professionals, related service providers, community professionals and parents interested in assisting children who have experienced brain injury. The focus for the week will be on formal and informal assessments to identify impairments after BI and the appropriate cognitive interventions and strategies to support the student’s academic performance and behaviors in both the classroom and in the community. Again this year will be a session on transition supports and resources. The format includes lecture, open discussions, video presentations, guest speakers, four case studies and shared learning. **All materials & textbooks are provided.**

Complete your registration EARLY. Applications and fees are due by Friday May 16, 2014.

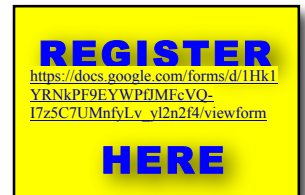
Registrations without accompanying fees will not be considered complete, however a \$100 deposit will hold your space with payment in full required by Monday, 06/02/14.
